STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE TO DPIIT REGISTRATION FOR START-UPS

Step 1: Meet Eligibility Criteria

DPIIT registration is primarily for start-ups that meet certain criteria:

- 1. **Incorporation Age:** The entity should not be more than 10 years old from the date of incorporation.
- 2. Entity Type: The entity must be a private limited company, partnership firm, or limited liability partnership (LLP).
- 3. Turnover: Annual turnover should not exceed ₹100 crores in any financial year.
- 4. **Innovation or Improvement**: The business should work on innovation, development, improvement of products, processes, or services, or have a scalable business model.
- 5. **No Reconstruction**: The start-up should not have been formed by splitting or reconstructing an existing business.

Step 2: Register Your Business

Ensure your business is registered under the relevant laws:

- **Private Limited Company** under the Companies Act, 2013.
- Partnership Firm under the Indian Partnership Act, 1932.
- LLP under the Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008.

Step 3: Create an Account on the Start-up India Portal

- 1. Visit the Start-up India website.
- 2. Click on the 'Register' button and create an account.
- 3. Fill in the required details such as name, email, and mobile number to complete the registration process.

Step 4: Apply for DPIIT Recognition

- 1. Log in to the Start-up India Portal using your credentials.
- 2. Go to **DPIIT Recognition** under the **Start-up Recognition** section.
- 3. Fill out the DPIIT application form, which includes:
 - o Details of the company (name, incorporation date, address, etc.).
 - Director/partner details.
 - o Business activities.
 - Supporting documents.

Step 5: Upload Required Documents

You need to upload the following:

- 1. Certificate of Incorporation/Registration of the company/firm/LLP.
- 2. **Description of Business** and how it is innovative or scalable.
- 3. **Proof of Funding** (if applicable).
- 4. Patent or Trademark Certificates (if applicable).
- 5. Awards or Certificates of recognition (if any).

Step 6: Submit the Application

- Once all details and documents are filled in, submit the application.
- A reference number will be provided for tracking the status.

Step 7: Verification and Approval

- The DPIIT will review your application. If additional details are required, they may contact you.
- Once approved, the **DPIIT Registration Certificate** will be issued and sent to your registered email ID. You can also download it from the portal.

Benefits of DPIIT Registration

- 1. Tax exemption under Section 80-IAC.
- 2. Exemption from Angel Tax.
- 3. Access to **Start-up India benefits**, like government funding and tenders.
- 4. Self-certification for compliance with certain labour and environment laws.
- 5. Faster processing of patent applications and IPR benefits.
