

WHY AVOID SINGLE-USE PLASTIC?

- Contributes to climate change.
- Clogs drains, causing flooding and waterborne diseases.
- (v) Takes hundreds of years to degrade.
- Harms food chains as animals ingest plastic.



AIMS AND OBJECTIVES



- **O** Promote sustainable alternatives to plastic.
- (v) Ban single-use plastic by 2025.
- Showcase India's commitment to sustainable development.



KEY TAKEAWAYS

- 2025 Target: Full ban on single-use plastic.
- Prohibited Actions: No use, stock, sell, trade, manufacture, or distribution of single-use plastic after 2025.



PENALTIES & TARGETS

- (√) Fines of ₹1 lakh to ₹5 lakh for violations.
- Complete plastic waste elimination by 2050.
- Everyone should seek eco-friendly packaging alternatives.



HOW THIS BILL DIFFERS

- Focuses specifically on banning single-use plastics.
- Sets clear deadlines for a 2025 ban and 2050 waste elimination.



- (v) Imposes stricter fines for violations.
- Requires a coordinated national strategy for plastic control.
